- 4. I'm making progress on all the **dissertation proposal** deadlines and assignments, but still have much work to do over the next couple months. Pray for focus, wise use of time and Spirit-empowered writing!

As always, we also ask you to **pray for Holly, Adam, Andrew and Alyssa** while I'm away as they partner with me in our mission work. Thank you for your extra intercession on our behalf. We are trusting God, and excited to see all He will do.
