

August is my planning and preparation month for the next 11 months packed with travel and training. Learn more about how <u>"preparation precedes presentation,"</u> including my schedule for the next four months. But for now, I want to appeal to you to **please pray** for my next international

trip coming up in a few weeks. I am scheduled to teach at two different Bible schools, one in **Mali** and one in **Central African Republic**. I have spent many dozens of hours preparing the curriculum, coordinating details with school administrators, researching and purchasing tickets, submitting for visas, etc. However, if you've been tracking the West Africa news, the **coup in Niger** has significant implications on many other countries, including where I plan to be. Please be fervent in prayer that the conflict will decrease instead of escalating. I am working closely with ReachGlobal leaders and local leadership on the ground to monitor the situation and plan contingencies, but the next month offers many uncertainties. **God is over all**, so



rather than stressing I'm trying to trust God and be thankful. Please join me in prayer.
