ago when I led a conference in his region. Musa has been yearning to **receive more training** in how to study and teach God's Word well, and has become closely connected to Pastor Enock, with whom I've been working for the past three years. Enock has been passing on to Musa all I've been giving him, which is a **great example of the multiplication** we are after.

They also plan to return to a group of 16 pastors in <u>Rwanda</u> in mid-September.
