Early Thursday November 12, I am scheduled to fly to Kinshasa, Congo for our next pastor training. Congo is one of our most difficult countries to enter because there are so many requirements. Long story short, **getting my visa** has been a fiasco, and the Congolese Embassy in Washington DC still has my passport and has not processed the visa. They must have it completed by Tuesday so I can receive it on Wednesday to fly out early Thursday. God is able to move people in the embassy to finish processing the visa guickly, so **PLEASE PRAY** TO THIS END.
